

## Child & Youth Support Worker 4 month contract

Manitoulin Family Resources requires one individual, for four months, to fill the position of a Child and Youth Support Worker to support women and children in our emergency residence/shelter program. The Child and Youth Support Worker provides emotional support to children and their mothers, provides relief to mothers residing in the shelter, provides support to children through interactive activities facilitating non-violent resolution, and is responsible to work with mothers in assisting in the development of non-violent disciplining techniques. Household duties such as cooking and cleaning are required in addition to providing linkages to other services.

The successful candidate will have:

- A combination of experience and education in the field of human services, social services or a related field
- Familiarity with provision of client-led, trauma informed services and harm reduction philosophy
- Excellent interpersonal, planning, and communication skills
- Strong engagement, conflict resolution and advocacy skills
- Knowledge of community resources
- Demonstrated ability to work as part of a team and independently as well
- Demonstrated understanding and experience working with victims of woman abuse and children who have witnessed violence
- Experience with data entry and computer skills
- Demonstrated commitment to diversity, cultural competency, and anti-racist/anti-oppressive frameworks
- Current CPR/First Aid certification, Food Handler's Safety certificate, WHMIS certificate, valid driver's license, reliable form of transportation, clear Vulnerable Sector Screening, and insurable driver's abstract are all requirements of the position and ongoing conditions of hire
- Second language fluency in Ojibway and/or French is an asset

This position is a temporary contract and outside the bargaining unit. Flexibility in scheduling will be required to meet the needs of the shelter, with the position averaging 35 hours per week.
